

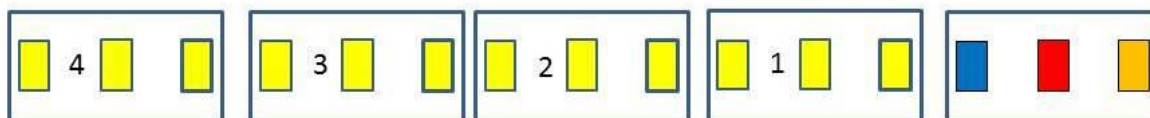
Start Procedure 2016 – 5-4-1-go

Start Lights

Starting is defined by a series of lights displayed on the front of the club house. 4 separate starts are catered for. The lights (as seen from the water) are illustrated in the figure below

Starting Lights

Start sequence from right to left
(as seen from the water)



There are 5 light boxes, 4 defining start process for up to 4 classes of boat, and one to indicate either one or more boats over the line or that a general recall has been called. A separate light (Red) is included to indicate when the Remote Start facility has been activated.

From right to left:

Box A. (Over the Line / Remote Start /General Recall)

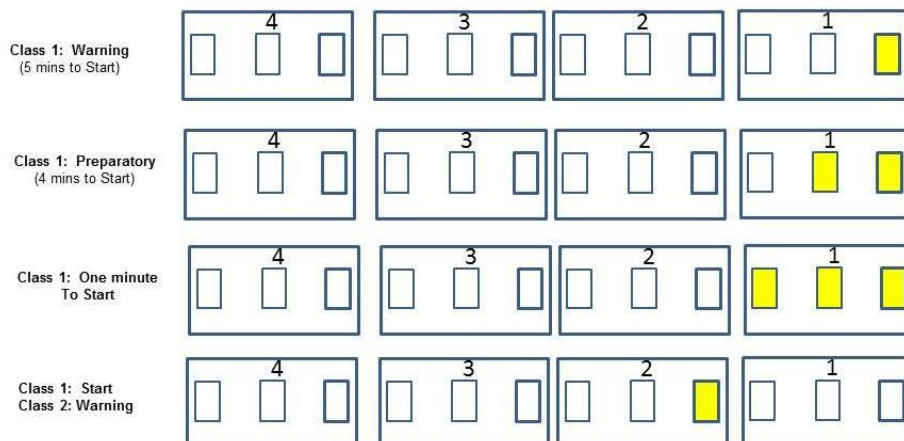
An **Amber** light, when illuminated and flashing indicates one or more boats were over the line at that class start.

A steady **Red** light indicates that the Remote Start has been activated and the prestart count down has started.

A **Blue** light, when illuminated and flashing indicates that a General Recall has been set (should be accompanied by two hoots on the hooter) and that start has been abandoned and all boats should return to the start area and prepare for a restart.

Box 1 (Start 1), Box 2 (start 2), Box 3 (start 3), Box 4 (start 4)

3 lights in each box indicate the start sequence as shown below:



and so on for each

start.

If starts are running normally there is no gap between start sequences.
